Frost Delay Policy

A change in the air accompanies Spring and Fall, as well as periodic frost delays during these parts of the season. As a reminder, when the grass is covered in frost, traffic on the frozen grass can do permanent damage, killing the plants or sometimes turn them black. Some mornings frost delays will be obvious and other days not as obvious. Holes # 2, 3, and 4 are 4 degrees colder in the valleys than the temperature at the clubhouse first thing in the morning. We are also colder at the golf course than the weather network or CKBW will report in town.

Please look for a frost delay sign near the putting green, and see the Golf Shop for further information if the sign is posted. When the frost lifts and play is opened, which is decided only by the superintendent, the order of play will be in order of the original tee sheet.

This means the first tee time is first off after the frost delay. Also, if you have a tee time later in the day, follow up with the Golf Shop to check for details regarding an expected delay. If you cannot make your re-scheduled tee time following the frost delay, you must cancel your tee time by calling the Golf Shop as soon as possible.

Thank you for understanding that the Maintenance and Golf Shop staff do everything within our power to place players on the course as early as possible following a frost delay.
